

**LOCAL LAW NO. 3-2018**

**A LOCAL LAW INCREASING TERM OF OFFICE  
OF TOWN HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT  
FROM 2 YEARS TO 4 YEARS**

**Be it enacted by the Hornellsville Town Board as follows:**

**Section 1. Intent and Authority.** The purpose of this local law is to permit the Town of Hornellsville to increase the term of office of the Town Highway Superintendent from 2 years to 4 years. Doing so would be in the administrative and financial interest of town government. It is adopted pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law Section 10, among other sections of that Law.

**Section 2. Increase of term of office.** The term of office for Town Highway Superintendent is hereby increased from 2 years to 4 years commencing with the term which begins January 1, 2020.

**Section 3. Repealer and Supersession.** All Local Laws or Ordinances or parts of Local Laws or Ordinances in conflict with any part of this Local Law are hereby repealed. In particular, this law is intended to supersede that portion of New York Town Law Section 24 which provides for a 2 year term of office for the office of Town of Highway Superintendent.

**Section 4. Severability.** The invalidity of any clause, sentence, paragraph or provision of this Local Law shall not invalidate any other clause, sentence, paragraph or part thereof.

**Section 5. Effective Date.** This Local Law shall be subject to mandatory referendum at the next biennial General Election and, if approved, shall take effect upon filing in the office of the New York Secretary of State and shall become operative on January 1, 2019.
