**LANE CLOSURES ALONG STATE ROUTE 36 IN HORNELL, STEUBEN COUNTY**

May 16, 2022 (Hornell, NY) – The New York State Department of Transportation is advising motorists that beginning Tuesday, May 17, traffic along State Route 36 in the City of Hornell, Steuben County, will be reduced to a single lane in each direction to facilitate a project to repair the bridges carrying Route 36 over the Canisteo River. Work is expected to be complete by mid-June.

Motorists should anticipate travel delays and build extra travel time into their schedule. Construction activities are weather dependent and subject to change based on conditions.

Motorists are urged to slow down and drive responsibly in work zones. Fines are doubled for speeding in a work zone. Convictions of two or more speeding violations in a work zone could result in the suspension of an individual's driver license.
